Prairie Sky Park Opens in Lone Tree

LONE TREE, CO – The City of Lone Tree is home to a new recreational park. The facility, named Prairie Sky Park, is located on Crossington Way in Lone Tree next to the Lone Tree Recreation Center. The grand opening event of the new park will take place on Saturday, May 9, 2009.

Residents are invited to enjoy the park on the day of the grand opening. Festivities include many free activities with numerous vendors in attendance. This event is set to be an exciting beginning for Prairie Sky Park. The Lone Tree Farmers Market will be on site from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and the Colorado Ultimate Frisbee Association will conduct free coaching clinics, pick up Frisbee games and an exhibition match to showcase this wonderful sport.

Local Lone Tree schools will hold fundraising activities to benefit the school children in the community with annual flower flat sales, Duffy rolls and more. Families of Lone Tree are encouraged to join the City for a few hours and enjoy a picnic in the park, bring kites and participate in free face painting, baseball games, music and more.

The 9.6 acre Prairie Sky Park is beautifully situated with spectacular mountain and downtown views and consists of a multi-purpose playing field, multi-purpose ball field, basketball court, shelter, walking/jogging path, benches and 2 playgrounds suited for five to 12 year olds. This well appointed park can be used during the day and evening with lighting and full landscaping.

A portion of the funding for Prairie Sky Park came from a grant through Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) in the amount of \$200,000. The City received the maximum award amount in the Local Government Parks and Outdoor Recreation category and was the first time the City applied for a GOCO grant.
